COMPLAINT AND DEMAND FOR
JURY TRIAL

Plaintiff as her claim alleges:

JURISDICTION AND VENUE

1. Plaintiff A LeiLani Jensen is resident and citizen of the state of Idaho, Ada County.
2. Defendant EcoEnergizer, Inc. is incorporated under the laws of Nevada, but has been at all times relevant hereto and is and has been doing some business in the state of Idaho. The Defendant, B. Robert Moore, is a resident of the state of Georgia, and is and was the President of the Defendant Corporation. The Defendant B. Robert Moore is personally liable to Plaintiff for some of her claims set forth herein.

Defendant Children's Fund International, Inc. is a Georgia corporation which did business in Idaho in connection with the note and loan which is one of the subjects of this litigation, that Defendant having been the repository and conduit of monies loaned by Plaintiff to and for the benefit of EcoEnergizer, Inc.

3. Venue and jurisdiction over this action lies in the state of Idaho because the Plaintiff is a resident of the state of Idaho and made a wire transfer of the loan which is the primary subject of this litigation from the state of Idaho. The wire transfer was made to the Defendant Children's Fund International, Inc. for the use and benefit of the Defendant Ecoenergizer, Inc. Venue and jurisdiction further lies in the state of Idaho by virtue of the fact that Ecoenergizer, Inc. has a marketing force of approximately 100 representatives in the state of Idaho for the marketing of its fuel additive product.

4. The amount in controversy exceeds the sum of \$100,000, exclusive of interest, costs, and attorneys fees.

FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION

5. On or about the 29th day of August, 2006 the Defendant Corporation and the Plaintiff entered into the Promissory Note, a copy of which is attached hereto as Appendix A and made a part hereof as though fully set forth herein, under the terms of which Note Plaintiff advanced to the Defendant the sum of \$77,000.

6. Under the terms of the Promissory Note, the Defendants became obligated to pay to the Plaintiff \$77,000 principle plus 20% of principle or a total of \$92,000. Additionally, the Note provides for interest at \$7,700 per month for which interest is presently due for the months of November and December of 2006 and January of 2007 for which three months the total sum due is \$23,100, together with future interest until the 5th day of March 2007.

7. Additionally, under the terms of the Note, Defendant Corporation promised to pay

Plaintiff a monthly payment of 0.154% (0.00154) of gross income, which gross income has exceeded \$800,000 per month making the estimated amount due Plaintiff approximately \$1,232 or more per month, or \$7,392 or more, total for six months. The payments have not been made and both principle and interest are due thereon.

8. Defendants have defaulted on their payments due under the terms of the Promissory Note, Appendix A, having made no payments thereon since October 2006, and therefore under an by the terms of the Promissory Note, the entire unpaid balance of the Note is immediately due and payable, together with interest, attorneys fees and costs.

SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION

9. Plaintiff re-pleads paragraphs 1 through 8 as though fully set forth herein.

10. Additionally there was an agreement between the Plaintiff and the Defendant EcoEnergizer and the Defendant B. Robert Moore that Plaintiff, as a shareholder would receive the sum of 1% of gross income each month. Defendant made payments of \$8,000 for the months of August and September, 2006 and \$10,000 for the month of October 2006 and has made no subsequent payments, for which there is presently an amount due of \$24,000 or more, plus interest.

THIRD CAUSE OF ACTION

11. Plaintiff re-pleads paragraphs 1 though 10 above as though fully set forth herein.

12. Defendant EcoEnergizer, Inc. has wrongfully and illegally attempted to effect a removal of Plaintiff as a member of the Board of Directors, which action should be nullified with the Court awarding a Declaratory Judgment to the effect that Plaintiff remains a member of the Board of Directors.

WHEREFORE Plaintiff prays judgment as follows:


1. For the monies due her under paragraphs 1 through 10 above.

2. For reasonable attorney fees.
3. For her costs and such other and further relief as may be meet and equitable in the premises.
4. For Declaratory Judgment reinstating Plaintiff as a member of the Board of Directors of EcoEnergizer, Inc.

PROMISORY NOTE

PRINCIPAL SUM: \$77,000

EFFECTIVE DATE: August 29, 2006

In installments as herein state, for value received, EcoEnergizer, Inc., promises to pay Aloha LeiLani Jensen ("Holder"), or order, the sum of NINETY-TWO THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$92,400) with interest from the date of this Note, on the unpaid original principal (\$77,000) at the rate of ten percent (10%) per month (\$7,700 per month), principal and interest payable as follows:

Seventy-Seven Hundred, or more, on the fifth day of each calendar month, commencing on the first day of October, 2006, and continuing until the fifth day of March, 2007, on which date the entire unpaid balance of principal and interest shall be due and payable.

Additionally, EcoEnergizer agrees to provide to Holder on or before the 10th day of each month during the term of this Agreement a monthly payment of 0.154 percent (%) of gross income for the preceding month generated by EcoEnergizer for a period of 6 months commencing the Effective Date.

Holder hereof may, at its option, declare the entire unpaid balance of this obligation immediately due and payable if any of the following events shall occur:

Default in the payment of any installment of this note for more than thirty (30) days after the due date thereof.

If EcoEnergizer fails to make any of the required payments or any part thereof, or in any way defaults on this Agreement, the parties enter into stipulated judgment and all amounts or sums previously paid will be forfeited to Holder and Holder may execute on the entire amount of the judgment.


Payments, without offset or counterclaim, shall be made in lawful money of the United States of America at Lithia Springs, Georgia


Presentment for payment, notice of dishonor, protest and notice of protest are hereby waived.
